**Kiewit Building Group and RNL Employees Commit to Helping
Bruce Randolph High School Students Excel**

Employees will assist students with their college applications, in addition to providing career advising and development sessions for students considering work in the design, construction, and engineering fields.

DENVER, January 7, 2010 – Kiewit Building Group has made a commitment to helping Denver Public School students at Bruce Randolph high school with their pursuit of higher education and careers. Employees of the Denver Kiewit offices, as well as employees of their partner RNL, a Denver based architecture firm, will offer students counseling on the college application process, as well as seminars on careers in the fields of design, construction, and engineering.

“Kiewit has long been a service-focused organization, and who better to reach out to the future leaders and employees of this city,” said Mike Colpack of Kiewit’s Denver office. “Our hope is that these outreach projects help the students at Bruce Randolph as they focus their efforts on the next step of their lives.”

On January 11 and January 13, 2011 Kiewit Building Group and RNL employees will donate two hours of their day to meet with Bruce Randolph high school seniors and assist them one-on-one with the college application and scholarship application processes. Volunteers will review essays, work on short answer questions for the applications and provide insight into critical lessons for students in their first collegiate semester.

“The college application process can be daunting, particularly in a tight economy with college enrollments on the rise.” said Tom Wuertz, RNL. “Offering our employees to serve as counselors and advisors to Bruce Randolph students is something we hope will make the process more approachable and the college experience more enjoyable.”

Upon completion of the application intensive sessions, Kiewit Building Group and RNL will hold monthly, hour-long sessions on careers in design, construction and engineering. Field, craft, and office personnel will meet with the high school seminar classes (comprised of juniors and seniors) to discuss the variety of careers available within construction, architecture and engineering.

Kiewit chose to focus on Bruce Randolph because it is directly adjacent to a new Denver Human Services Eastside Office they are building at 3815 Steele Street.



The new Denver Human Services Eastside Office will be a full service location providing a continuum of human services to the community. This new location will open in Fall of 2011 and provide Child Support Enforcement, Homeless Outreach, Veterans Services, Child Welfare Services and visitations, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families, Family Medicaid, Electronic Benefit Transfer, Adult Protection Services, Food Assistance, Low-Income Energy Assistance Program, Employment First and Colorado Works/TANF.

“In addition to the new Human Services Office currently under construction, it seemed intuitive to us to supplement our expanding community role by reaching out to the students in our neighborhood,” continued Mike Colpack of Kiewit Building Group in Denver. “Our students are the future of our city, and Kiewit is committed to supporting them in every way we can.”

The college application intensive sessions will take place from 1:30 p.m. – 4 p.m. on January 11, and 2 p.m. to 4 p.m. on January 13. Students and Kiewit and RNL employees will be available to speak with media about the partnership.
